Location

SALMON BROOK PARK is a 116-acre town-owned recreation facility located ½ mile south of Granby Center on Routes 10 & 202. SBP is open to all residents of Granby as a place to enjoy leisure pursuits. The Park is also host to many special events such as sports competitions and the summer concert series. SBP is an alcohol-free facility.

Facilities Include

BALLFIELDS: Several ball fields are available for resident use; however, scheduled Little League games and Town activities have priority use. Little League offers spring and summer youth programs and the Town offers a summer baseball clinic.

BANDSHELL: The Granby Recreation Dept. sponsors a series of FREE concerts – *Sounds of Summer* – with performers selected especially for families. All concerts are supported entirely through donations from local businesses.

BASKETBALL COURTS: Four (4) courts located near the playground.

BATHHOUSE: Located at the entrance to the pond. The Beach House has locker rooms for changing and restroom facilities.

CHILDREN'S MEMORIAL GARDEN: A quiet place across from the tennis courts near the park entrance; especially for those who have lost children. To purchase a brick in memory of a child or to make a donation, call the Recreation Office.

DOG PARK: A special play area for off-leash dogs to mingle with their animal friends. Dogs must have a valid license, be current in shots and wear a collar with ID. Owners must stay with their pets and clean up after their dogs. No dogs in heat, dogs younger than four months, sick dogs and aggressive animals are allowed. Children are to remain with a parent at all times and must not chase dogs or sit on the ground. Children under 8 are not allowed in the dog park.

HORSE EXERCISE AREA: This fenced area is located near the far end of the park. Riding trails are accessible from there.

HORSESHOES: Two (2) pits are located next to the Basketball courts. Bring your own equipment.

PAVILIONS: Two (2) Pavilions are available for large groups or family outings. To assure availability, reservations are to be made at the Recreation Office. Day Camp, recreation activities and those with reservations have priority use. Applications must be accompanied by a security deposit and applicable User fees.

POND HOUSE: This facility features a program room, suitable for rental for small parties and events any time of year. A gas fireplace and available catering ready-kitchen are additional facility features. A conference room is also available for small meetings. The Pond House is also home to the Granby Recreation Department's Administrative Offices.

PLAYGROUNDS: There are two (2) playgrounds available for children. The Tot Lot/Playscape is located near the tennis courts for ages 2-10 and the Playscape for ages 5-12 is located near the basketball courts.

SNACK SHACK: The Snack Shack is open evenings & Saturdays during Little League season, during the evening *Sounds of Summer* concerts and Saturdays 8:30AM – 3:30PM during the fall soccer season. Hot and cold beverages, hot dogs, burgers, pizzas, Italian ice, chips & candy are available.

SOCCER FIELDS: Numerous soccer fields are located at the Park. The Town youth soccer program is active during the fall; the Rovers Soccer Club has both spring & fall programs.

SWIMMING: There is a man-made pond with a sandy beach and a raft. The pond opens mid-June through the end of August. Lifeguards are on duty. Swim lessons and special activities are offered throughout the summer season. There is a daily admittance fee or seasonal memberships are available. The 10/15 rule applies. The brook is an UNGUARDED WATER AREA – no lifeguards on duty.

TENNIS COURTS: There are four (4) courts located near the entrance to the Park. These courts are available on a first-come basis at no charge or by reservation. A maximum of three (3) courts may be reserved at a time. Town-sponsored clinics and those with reservations have priority use. Reservations may be made in person at Rec Department up to seven (7) days in advance. RESERVATION FEE: \$4.00/1½hours.

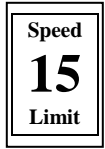
VETERAN'S WALL: A memorial to the men and women of Granby who have served our country.

General Park Notes



Both SBP & Ahrens Parks have a speed limit – please obey it for the safety of the many users, especially young children.



Parking is permitted in designated areas only. Cars parked in non-compliance locations will be ticketed.



DOGS: Dogs must be on a leash at all times except in the Dog Park. *Please clean up after your pet.* There are disposal bags & boxes available for your convenience near the entrance gates for both Parks.

Animals are NOT allowed on the tennis courts, the ball fields, in the Playground areas OR in areas with crowds.



The Dog Park is NOT a children’s playground. Please do not let children chase the dogs or sit on the ground.

Ahrens Park

PARK HOURS: 1 Hour before Sunrise to 1 Hour after Sunset

Location

AHRENS PARK is a 55-acre town-owned recreation facility located on Hungary Road .6 mile from Route 20 in the center of Granby. Portable bathroom facilities are available. Parking is NOT allowed on Hungary Road.

Facilities Include

COMMUNITY GARDENS: Gardens are available on a yearly basis for a nominal fee. If you are interested in renting a plot, please contact our office for contact name & number.

LACROSSE: Lacrosse fields are located in the rear of the Park. Granby Youth Lacrosse holds spring programs.

MULTI-PURPOSE FIELDS: Fields for soccer & other sports are available for use. These fields are used by Granby Youth Soccer in the fall.

PAVILION: This Pavilion is available to rent; see PAVILION info above under SBP and follow the same procedures.

SENIOR BASEBALL FIELD: This field opened in the spring of 2006 and is available for use by the Senior Little League players.

FOOTBALL PRACTICE AREA: This area opened in the summer of 2008 and is the home of Granby’s Youth Football program.
